






Charter of Trade

New American Colonies

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting. WHEREAS for the greater Good and Benefit of all Members in good standing of the New American Colonies and the better Furtherance, Strengthening, and Establishing of an economic network to promote Trade, Travel, and Commerce among and between these Colonies, this Charter of Trade hereby CONFIRMS and GIVES to the Grantee (“Company”) a License to Promote, Advertise, and Market within the Colonies, and Permit to participate in programs of Trade, Travel, Commerce, and Exchange thereto. This Charter does further give and grant to the Company the entitlement, subject to State and Federal laws, to take, load, carry, and transport within the Colonies (in whatsoever manner deemed most expedient and cost effective) Victuals, Manufactured Goods, all Manner of Clothing, Implements, Furniture, Cattle, Horses, and all other Things necessary for Trade with the People there and for the Peaceable Commerce of all.

Furthermore, having recognized the importance and contributions of our Manufacturing and Construction industries, our Sustainable Family Farms, and our Small Businesses in supporting our Nations Economic Growth, Health, and Prosperity, this Charter of Trade confirms that the Company is American owned and that  if involved in Manufacturing or Construction, its Products are Fabricated, Assembled, Erected, and Produced primarily in America and by American workers, and/or;  if involved in Agriculture, that its Products are Grown and Raised on American soil and in a Socially and Environmentally responsible manner and/or;  if involved in the Restaurant and Food Service industries, that it will support Sustainable Family Farm Agriculture by offering Customers choices that include Locally Grown, Healthy Foods produced without the use of Synthetic Fertilizers, Pesticides, Growth Hormones, or Antibiotics, and/or,  if a Leisure or Hospitality related company, that it will participate in programs designed to promote American Tourism and encourage Travel between the Colonies, and;  if a Small Business and if involved in a Wholesale, Retail, or a Service type industry, that Company will endeavor to support other Community Businesses by “Buying Locally, Buying American, & Buying Responsibly,” and/or;

Finally, in recognition that the Colonies are Connected by the strongest ties that can Unite Societies, that the Company will also endeavor, whenever possible, to Make Use Of, Apply, Purchase, and Utilize products and services of other Colony Members for the benefit of all.
